- Application will be filled Online by the candidates on www.apprenticeship.gov.in
- The examination is valid for one entry only.
- Online registration will commence on **07.12.2025** and will close on **30.12.2025**. Only online registered application will be accepted.
- Following documents are required during registration/selection:-
 - High School (Class 10) and ITI (NCVT) in relevant trades with minimum 40% marks (aggregate). Std XII with minimum of 50% marks will be given priority.
 - Passport size recent colour photograph of size not larger than 50 KB in front portrait with light background, without head gear except for Sikhs. The photograph is to be taken with the candidates holding a black slate in front of his chest, with his name clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters.
 - Candidate's left hand thumb impression.
 - Candidate's signature image.
- Candidate must have his/her valid e-mail and mobile number for successful online registration.
- Candidates should have his/her Aadhar Card number handy.
- Candidates are to reach the examination centre with colour printout of provisional admit card. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in the written exam in case anomalies /irregularities in correct information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of the selection process.
- The candidates will carry a valid ID proof whenever he/she reports for selection test and medicals.
- The selection for engagement of the apprentices will be based on Merit taking into consideration the total aggregate marks scored in the selection process. Incomplete application will be rejected. **The reservations for engagement of Apprentice will be admissible as per the apprenticeship act 1961, Rule 5 of Apprenticeship Rules 1992.** The period of training for the individual trades have been specified on the website. Candidates who already completed/undergoing apprenticeship training are not eligible.
- No TA/DA will be payable for attending the selection process. The candidates will have to make their own arrangement for stay during the selection.
- Caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC as applicable.

- Medical standards: Height:** Minimum acceptable height is 152 Cm. **Weight:** Minimum of 48 Kg. **Hearing:** Candidates should have a normal hearing i.e able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 mtrs with each ear separately. **Dental:** Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. **Health:** He should be free from any active or latent. Acute or chronic, medical or surgical disability or infection or skin ailment. Candidate shall be physically and mentally fit to undergo the courses in any climate. A valid medical certificate issued by Medical Officer (Gazetted), as to having been medically examined as per medical standards, enumerated in apprenticeship act 1961, is to be submitted to **Base Repair Depot, Air Force, Chandigarh** for scrutiny at the time of selection process.

- Stipend:-** During the course, the candidate will be paid stipend of Rs. 10,500/- per month.
